



The Baldwin Center Inclement Weather Policy

When the Stratford Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather, Baldwin Center activities, including classes, clubs, lunch and transportation are cancelled. The Baldwin Center is open for non-structured activities such as billiards, board games and cards. Staff report to The Baldwin Center during their regularly scheduled hours. When the Stratford Public Schools have a delayed opening, Baldwin Center activities, including classes and clubs prior to 11:00am, are cancelled. Activities will resume at 11:00 am. Please note that instructor-led classes scheduled to start at, or after, 11:00 am may be cancelled if the instructor is unable to get to the Baldwin Center. A "make-up" class will be scheduled for any classes that are cancelled due to inclement weather or instructor absence. Call the Baldwin Center if you are unsure if your class will take place. Lunch is served at 11:45am. Cancellation or delay of transportation services is determined by staff.

When the Town of Stratford municipal buildings are closed, have a delayed opening or an early closing, the Baldwin Center does the same. If travel becomes hazardous during the day, bus passengers will be transported home. No passenger will be left stranded. Baldwin Center closings and delays will be publicized on News Channel 12, WICC radio, and posted on the website at www.townofstratford.com/seniorservices.
